
His teammates have truly benefitted from having him part of this group this season and feed off his energy he brings EVERY day!


Here are some specific examples of how Joseph exemplifies the attributes of the Junior Bomber of the Year:

U11 B Roman Jacklyn




The U11B nominee for Junior Bomber of the year is Roman Jacklyn.

Roman is not afraid to work on his deficiencies and will work hard in practice as well as on his own to get better.






U14 BB Emric Worron


U15 A Oscar Hurst

U16 BB Jacob Fehrman




U18 AA Nick Lagges
